To help with this process, the City of Parkersburg and the Wood County Commission have committed \$50,000.00 to facilitate this project. The City of Vienna hereby dedicates \$10,000 in the furtherance of this action.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VIENNA**, as set out on the West Virginia COVID-19 website and map located at <https://dhhr.wv.gov/COVID-19/Pages/default.aspx>, whenever the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources assigns Wood County the color "red" based upon COVID-19 infection rate or percent positivity, all in-person meeting participants and attendees for any City of Vienna public meeting shall appropriately wear a mask regardless of vaccination status.
