SAFETY TIPS

- Walkers and runners, are urged to follow a few safety tips in order to be seen by drivers.
- Use the side of the road facing oncoming traffic (except on curves, where it is best to walk on the outside edge of the curve).
 - Use sidewalks where available, or stay as close as possible to the edge of the road.
 - At night, wear light-colored or reflective clothing, or carry a light to help you be seen.
 - Be very careful at intersections.
 - **Walkers and runners are discouraged from using the parking lanes on Grand Central.**
